- Notes:**
1. ACSA will obtain from its contracted utilities contractor a cost to install services on dual lane highways and other problematic installations for applicant reimbursement of ACSA for the service installation.
  2. Connection fees for a water service larger than 1", sewer service larger than 4", water or sewer service on a dual lane highway, and all commercial and industrial availability fees shall be determined by the Director.
  3. Based on estimated average daily water use of 275 gallons per day, equal to one Equivalent Residential Unit. For greater estimated water use, see Note 4 below.
  4. There are 4 methods of determining availability fees other than the above chart. See below. If the average daily water usage is provided, the Director will determine fees using all 5 methods and assess the lowest.
    - (a) Amherst County Code, Chapter 15, Article IV, Section 15-124, Tables 1 and 2;
    - (b) Estimating average daily water usage based on plumbing fixture counts and/or occupancy, dividing by 275 gallons per day to determine the number of Equivalent Residential Units, and multiplying by the residential availability fee.
    - (c) Using (b) above with the documented average daily water usage of similar facilities.
    - (d) Using (b) above with an estimate of daily water usage sealed by a licensed architect or engineer on the estimator's letterhead.
 (b), (c), and (d) may require execution by the applicant of a written agreement with ACSA that, if actual average daily water usage exceeds the estimate, an additional availability fee will be assessed.
